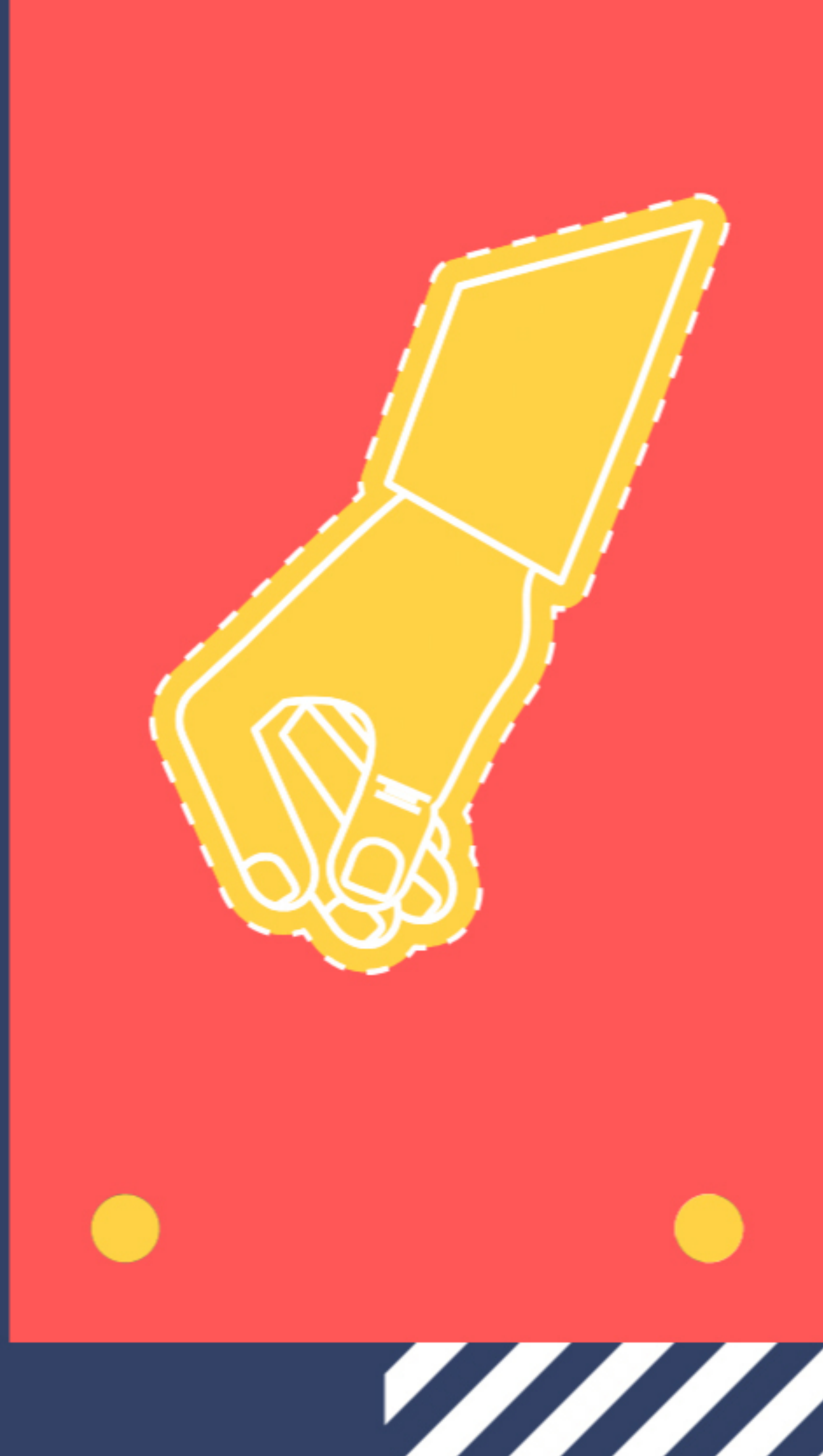

Dropped Items

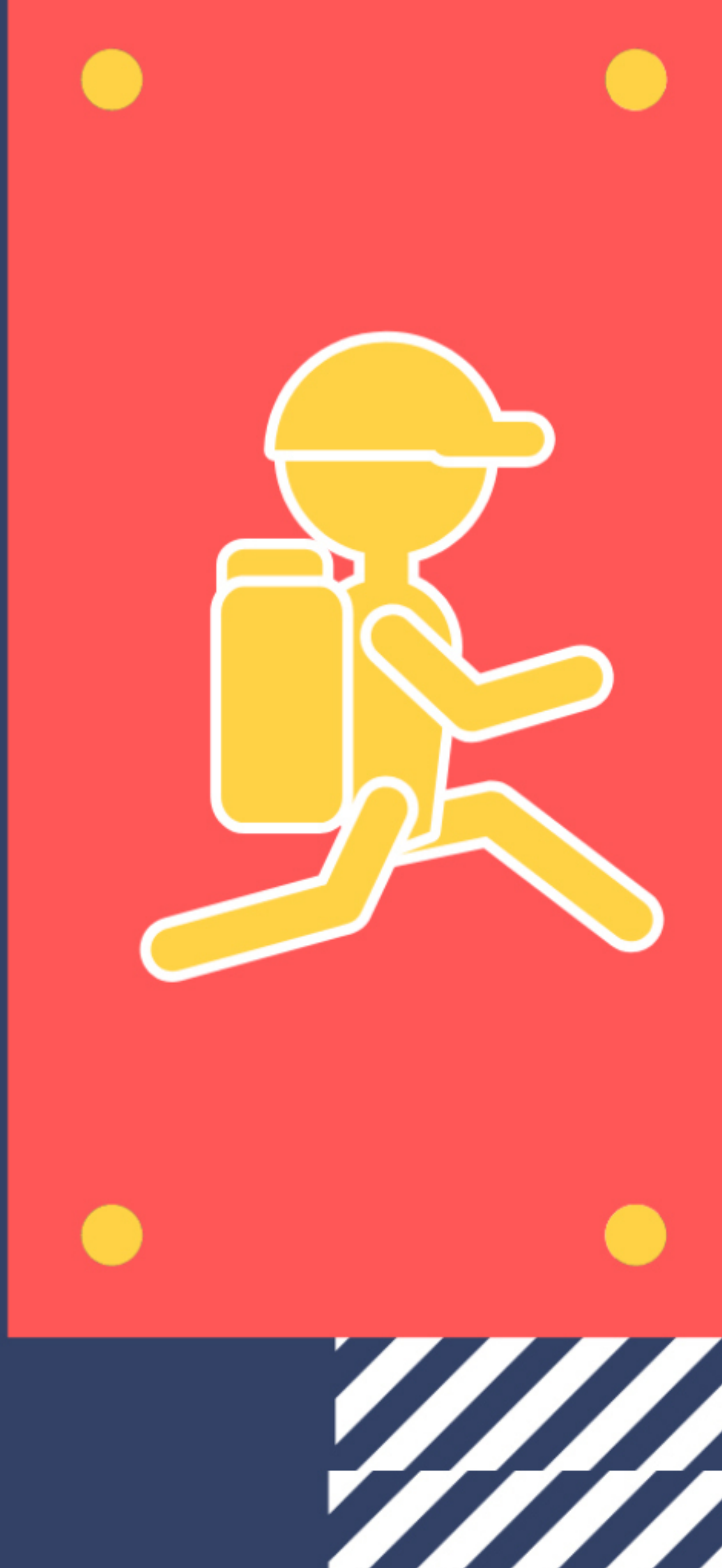
If the child drops something, they should tell the bus driver and make sure the bus driver is able to see them before they pick it up.

Straps & Drawstrings

Be careful of straps or drawstrings that could get caught in the door.

3 Giant Steps

Stay 3 giant steps back from the curb as the school bus approaches.

Passenger Back Wheel

Do not go near the passenger back wheel of the bus. This is one of the most dangerous areas of the bus.

5 Giant Steps

If the child needs to cross the street after exiting the bus, the child needs to take 5 giant steps in front of the bus, look at the bus driver and wait for the bus driver to motion it is safe to cross.
